Recycle Right...

Effective immediately, the Middlesex County Improvement Authority is **strictly** enforcing NJ State recycling regulations. As a reminder to Township residents, recyclables in plastic bags are **NOT** acceptable. No plastic bags of any kind or any color can be used at the curb or they will be rejected. Contaminated recyclables can also be rejected. A few simple guidelines to follow:

- Recycle plastic bags at the supermarket, *NOT* at your curb
- Only #1 and #2 plastics are accepted, *NOT* all plastics are recyclable
- Empty and rinse out cans, bottles and food containers
- Clean cardboard only, no oily pizza boxes!
- When in doubt, throw it out!
