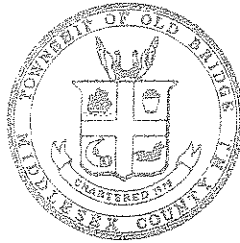

## TOWNSHIP OF OLD BRIDGE


Dear Old Bridge Township Resident:

Over the last several years, I have received numerous complaints regarding the dangerous condition of Disbrow Road between Amboy Road (County Route 689) and New Jersey State Highway Route 34. Also, the Old Bridge Township Council and our Old Bridge Township staff have been made aware of the public safety concerns of this roadway. It is our collective goal to address this matter and improve the quality of life. To that end, the Township has reviewed alternatives to make Disbrow Road safer and, including but not limited to, roadway realignment and widening alternatives, one-way access and, more recently, making Disbrow Road a dead end.

For your review, I have attached an initial proposed plan depicting where Disbrow Road would end if it were made a dead-end street. This approach will give access to all properties along Disbrow Road but will eliminate cut through traffic on this substandard roadway. We also believe this will have a positive impact on the Disbrow-Amboy Road intersection and address all issues raised in your complaints.

Given that you may be impacted by any changes to this roadway, we welcome your input and suggestions to help address this issue. We will compile your feedback on this initial improvement plan to make Disbrow Road a dead-end street and present this information to the Old Bridge Township Council at its August 10, 2020 Township Council Meeting. Your time and input are greatly appreciated as we work together to address this public safety matter.
